

Psychology Major Concentrations

The IUPUI Psychology Department provides students with the opportunity to develop a concentration in a particular sub-discipline of psychology by successfully completing a minimum of **(a) one core course (except for Behavioral Neuroscience and the Psychology of Addictions, which require two), (b) two specialization courses, and (c) one capstone course** aligned with one of the four areas of psychology listed below. Concentrations are recommended for students who are considering graduate school or employment in one of these areas. Students who have successfully completed the requirements for one of these concentrations will receive a notification of completion on their transcript. Students should consult an academic advisor for more information about pursuing one of these concentrations and should officially apply for a concentration by completing and submitting the *Application for a Track Concentration* available in the Psychology Department office (LD 124) or online from the Graduation Requirements Section of the Undergraduate Section of the Psychology Department website (www.psych.iupui.edu).
